- TikTok is just another tool to tell your story
- Trends come and go; focus on constants





MULTIDIMENSIONAL CONTENT

- Some sort of action; exposition that can be told through video
- A process that can be illustrated (expression, graphics, clips)
- Strong characters that can offer quotes or compelling testimony
- Elicits some form of emotional reaction
- Information is complementary, not redundant
- Your message/page/brand is presented in a nonlinear format
- Audience is active: engage them directly






BEYOND "BEGINNING," "MIDDLE," AND "END"

- Break it down into constituent parts
- Who are the main characters in your story?
- What is the event or situation? What is the context?
- When is it happening? Now? Future? Past historical context?
- Where is it happening? Different parts of the nation or world?
- Why is it happening? What different elements led to the problem?
- How did it happen? How do we fix it?
- Understanding these parts will help you decide what media are necessary to tell your story

EXAMPLES!





SIX CONTENT LANES

- 1. Update Me the classic news brief
- 2. Keep me on trend "What's trending right now?"
- 3. Give me perspective What are the different perspectives on a given topic?
- 4. Educate Me Teach me something (i.e. History or Science Lessons)
- 5. Inspire me Inspirational stories
- 6. Divert Me Funny or shocking videos

TECHNICAL CHECKLIST

- 1. At least :60, less than 3 min.
- 2. Cut out pauses, breathing, filler words
- 3. Don't bury the lede!
- 4. Decent lighting and audio (clear image, clear sound)
- 5. Jarring visual change in first two seconds; after that, every five
- 6. Script it out informally, make bullet points, use a teleprompter
- 7. Your audience will reflect your presenter
